
The event was conducted under the guidance of Mrs. Sushma Devi, PGT DOE Delhi. She is a Special Education Teacher, currently teaching at Government Sarvodaya Vidyalaya, Sector-6 Rohini.

The session began with a cordial welcome of Ma'am Sushma by the UBA team. She began by telling the students about the need for and importance of sign language. The difference between hearing impairment and hard of hearing was explained. Emphasis was put on the fact that many hearing problems can be cured if treatment is provided at the right time.

A beautiful quote to express the maladies of the deaf was used, "Deaf people want their voices to be heard as they are discriminated and ignored most of the time by policy makers. We want to be treated with equality, respect and dignity not to be isolated by the society. Laws made for our protection and welfare need to be implemented effectively and we should be made a part of the mainstream." Jaysing Kale, Hon. Secretary, SLAD.

The session then moved on to learning about ISL (Indian Sign Language), wherein students learned about the various gestures used for making a sign. All the alphabets were taught to the students, along with some common words and signs to express emotions like thank you, sorry, pain, etc.

Before concluding, Ma'am Sushma informed the participants about 'Ali Yavar Jung National Institute of Speech & Hearing Disabilities (AYJNISHD)' which aims to conduct, sponsor, coordinate or subsidize research into all aspects of education and rehabilitation of persons with hearing impairment.

Cloth Donation Drive


