

Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar (14 April 1891 – 6 December 1956), popularly known as **Babasaheb**, was an Indian jurist, economist, politician and social reformer who inspired the Modern **Buddhist** Movement and campaigned against social discrimination against Untouchables (Dalits), while also supporting the rights of women and labour. He was Independent India's first law minister and the principal architect of the Constitution of India. On this occasion, Maharaja Surajmal Institute of Technology (MSIT) (Affiliated to GGSIP University, Delhi) organized a Seminar on "Preamble of Constitution of India" on November 26, 2015 by inviting Dr. Anup Surendranath from National Law University, Delhi as Chief Guest for spreading awareness of the Constitution among its students and faculty members.
