

AICTE-Chhatra Vishwakarma Awards-2019

All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India held a competition “AICTE-Chhatra Vishwakarma Awards-2019” for the students with the aim to encourage and motivate young students and institutions to raise their performance in their specific domains leading to significant contribution towards the growth and development of the nation as a whole. The objective was to recognize and honour the innovative work of the students displaying exceptional skills in different categories. This year the problem statement was "How to enhance the income of Villages through intervention of Technology/Management practice(s)".

The first round involved submitting an idea prototype followed by submitting a short video clip or power point presentation of our proposed solution. It was judged on the basis of following parameters- originality of idea, technology used, feasibility and practical approach etc. After clearing the first two rounds, the team was called for regional convention which was held at JIMS on 10th Jan'2020 where we explained the working prototype to a panel of judges. Our project which was made under the "Farm and Flock" category was selected for the National Convention Round, held at AICTE Headquarters, Vasant Kunj, on 24th February,2020. It was an absolute honour to be amongst the 117 teams selected for the national round from more than 6000 applications. We were allotted a stall and enthusiastically presented our project to an esteemed panel of judges. Our project garnered praise from eminent personalities like AICTE Chairman, ministers from MHRD, professors from IITs etc.
