



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NSS MSIT in collaboration with Prakriti MSIT hosted a webinar in observance of World Youth Skills Day on July 15, 2021. The webinar was inspired by this year's Youth Skill Day theme, which honors youth's persistence and ingenuity in the face of hardship, as well as skill providers that have adapted their learning delivery techniques to suit the epidemic's requirements and was held on online meeting platform- Google Meet.

The event was effectively organized and implemented under the guidance of Ms. Chetna Sabharwal. She has over 25 years of expertise as an Educational Psychologist. She is the founder of 'Bass Ek Raah' and the director of SkillsReform Pvt. Ltd. She is also involved with national organizations such as NCERT and NOIS. Among her many accolades, the UCLA certified Life Coach has received the Business Leader Award 2021 - under 50 from Business Mint, as well as the 111 Power Women Award 2021.



It was a dynamic and insightful session with eye-catching presentations, question-and-answer sessions, and opportunities. She spoke about several crucial and demanding issues, such as the future of work and employment post Covid-19, key and timeless skills, brain-computer interface, employability quotient, personal branding, and transformation the students require. She enlightened the students extensively on using social media platforms, e-commerce prospering in the pandemic, and combining automated intelligence under the brain-computer interface. She discussed about Amazon, Alibaba, LinkedIn, Netflix, and Instagram, among other well-known websites and services and informed the students about their progress. She addressed the participants about employability quotient, which included emotional quotient, social quotient, creative quotient, spiritual quotient, tech quotient, and intelligence quotient. The student learned about the importance of the three A's: adversity, agility, and adaptability.




Transition skills, personal branding, development mindset, and transferable skills were also highlighted as timeless skills. The students were taught the value of these tools in advancing their careers and creating an appealing resume to impress employers and recruiters. The necessity of understanding where they are with those skills was underlined to the participants. In nearly every sector, whether in-office or virtual, communication skills will be critical in the future. Hence, the students were asked to inculcate better communication skills. For their future growth and advancement, the students were educated on the critical need of changing their mentality, self, and work environment. They were given all of the alternatives, and possibilities available to them, as well as how to make the best use of them.
