The session started by Mr. Manoj Sharma, Assistant Director, MSME. He quoted the example of Dhirubai Ambani defeating Bombay Dyeing and emphasized on the need to think beyond jobs and to start a business if anyone really want to be "rich". He informed about many offices of MSME and promised to help the new

start-ups falling under various schemes of MSME some of which are exclusively for Girls/ST/SC owners of MSME units.
