Event Coverage:

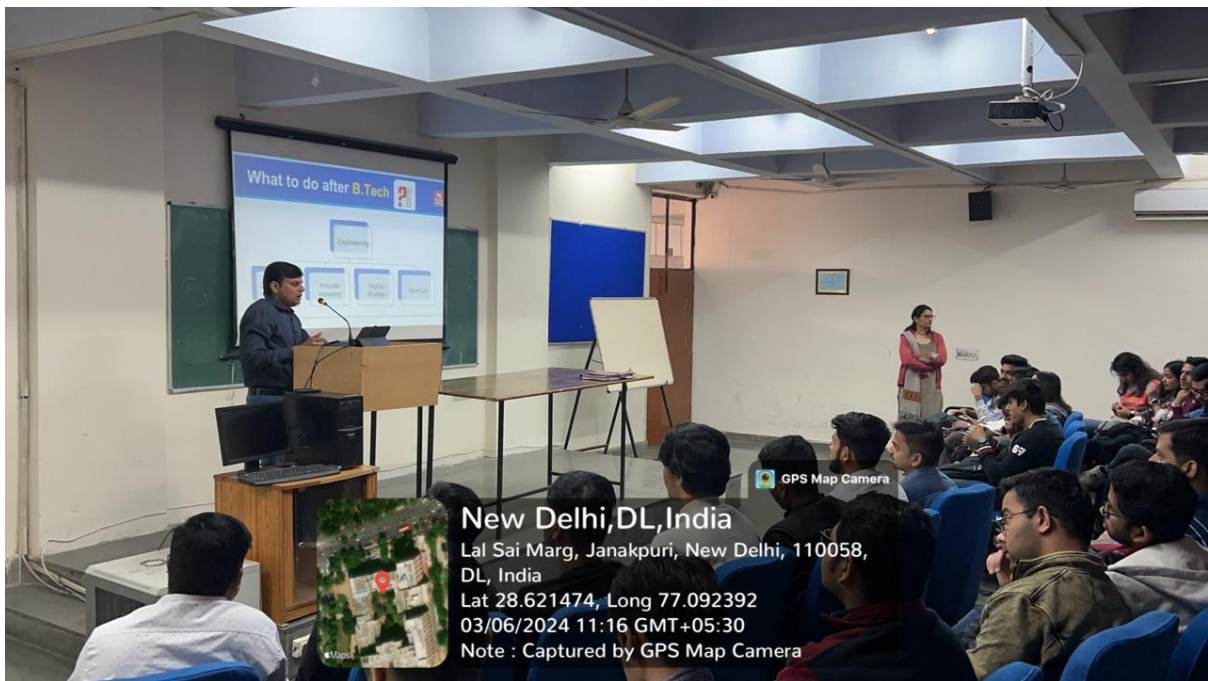
