Rs. 1 Lakh for 3 months. This session provided insights on how one can join this DMP and avail its amazing benefits.

Digital public goods are open-source software, open data, open AI models, open standards, and open content that adhere to privacy standards, other applicable laws, tech best practices, do no harm by design, and help attain the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The implementation of DPGs, often in conjunction with other building blocks is called Digital Public Infrastructure.
