Mr. Rawat also guided participants toward valuable resources for interview preparation, including:


- Online Platforms: LeetCode, CodeStudio, GeeksforGeeks, and HackerRank for coding practice.

- **Networking Strategies:** Utilizing LinkedIn to explore job opportunities and connect with industry professionals.


