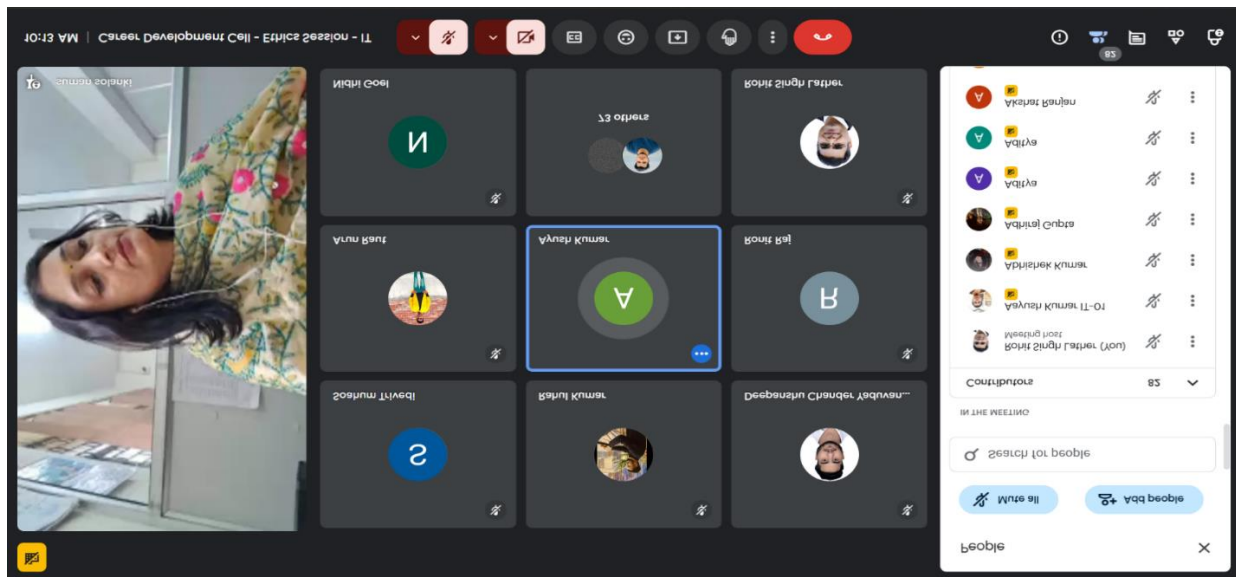

Introduction

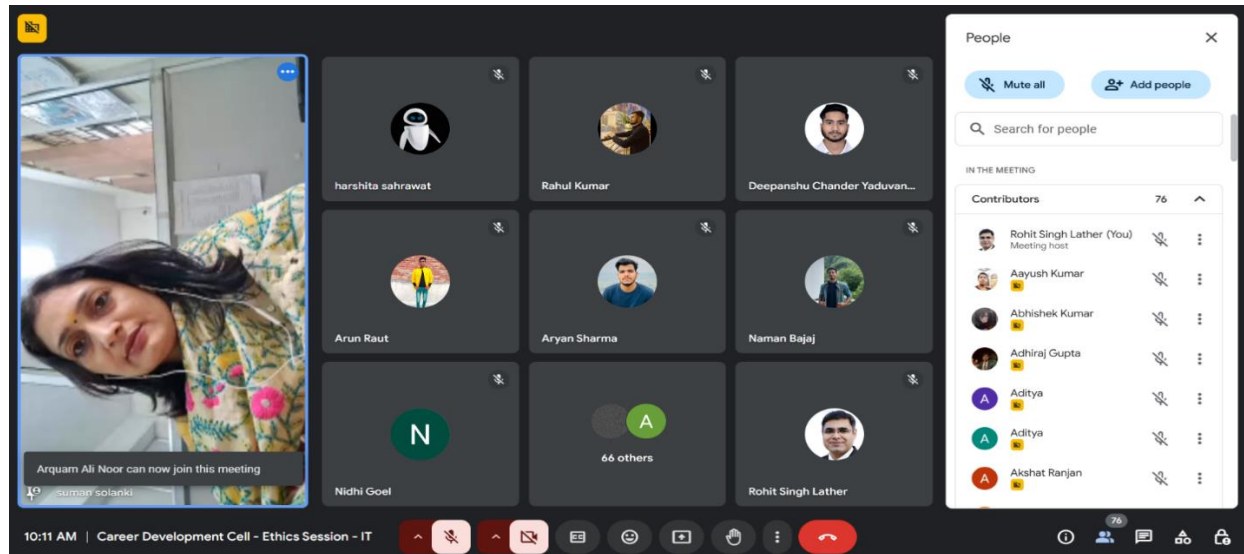

About Dr Suman Solanki

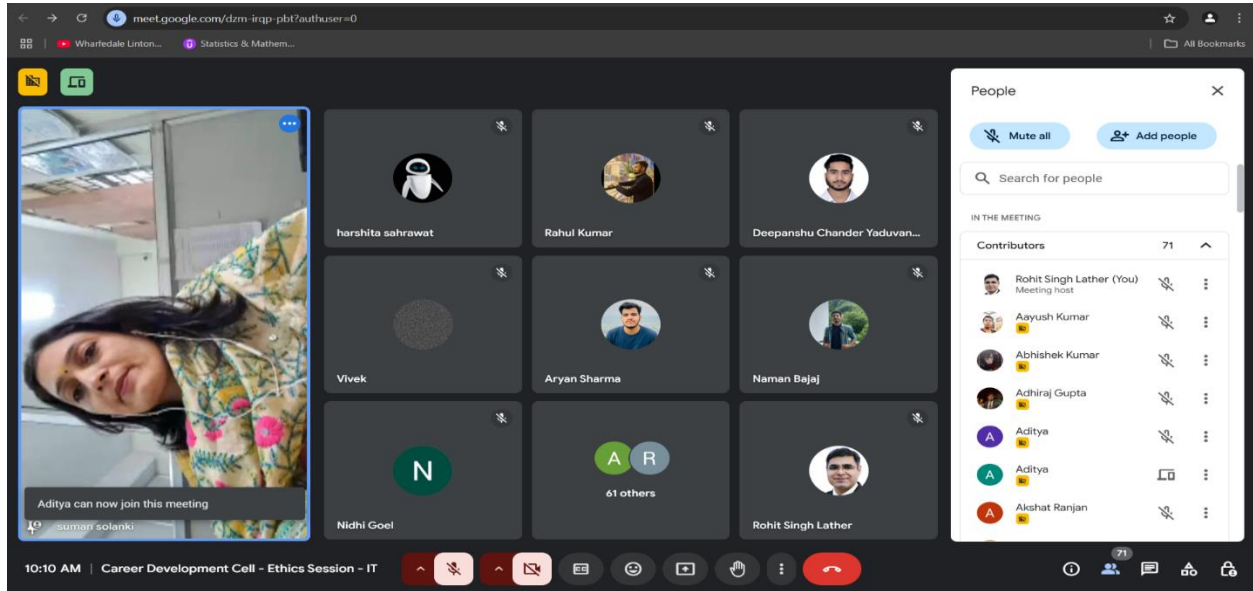
