The event aimed to foster innovation while promoting women's safety, empowerment, and technological advancements. Additionally, an Ideathon is also planned to be conducted on 21.02.2025 by the Institute Innovation Cell (IIC)
e	AC and Wi-Fi should be installed	ACs are already installed in labs, seminar halls, and conference room. Further, installation of ACs in classrooms will be the priority in the next phase of purchase. Wi-fi has been installed on the Ground floor for official purpose. Wi-fi is also available in both girls and boys common rooms.

i	There should be 2 more extra period in which student are provided education with relevance of technology that is used in industry to help them crack jobs	A Career Development Cell has been formed in the Institute to conduct activities / seminars related to personality development, resume building, placement interviews preparation etc. Seminars related to latest technologies are conducted by departments in every semester

There is no teaching load for final year students and 3 rd year (in few departments) on Saturdays in the present semester. While in few other departments, the teaching load for 3 rd year students has been reduced to minimum on Saturdays.

The IQAC Head welcomed Director, MSIT and all attendees of the meeting. The agenda was briefed and the following decisions were taken

1. Summary of College Feedback by students

The feedback given by final year students of all the department was discussed in detail for the year 2023-24 as summarized below

Department Level

2. It was told by the HODs that the subjects and labs related to latest technologies have been included in the latest scheme and syllabus of the Institute and subjects like Artificial Intelligence, Data Analytics, Machine Learning and IOT are present in the program core electives and emerging area electives.
3. Director MSIT suggested HODs to organize more Industrial visits and give exposure to all the students of 2nd and 3rd year students. She also advised IIC Cell Convener to forward all kind of opportunities to the departments for 8th sem students. Dr. Rohit Singh told that he will forward a new internship opportunities to the IIC Cell.

4. HODs told that the departments organize various technical seminars, workshops and industrial visits during the semester as required by the students.
5. Regarding ACs and Wi-fi, Director, MSIT advised the departments to forward the request for Wi-fi router for their floors. It was told that ACs have already been installed in labs and management will consider classrooms as well for ACs.
6. Regarding books, departments are requested to forward requisitions for new books to the Library Incharge based on subjects offered by respective departments.
7. Dr. Sudesh Pahal, Convener IIC Cell was suggested to organise Hackathons in the Institute. Also, participation in National Innovation Contests and other national-level events should be encouraged.
8. The Timetable Committee was advised to reduce 2nd year student's load on Saturdays in the coming semester. There is no teaching load for 3rd and final year students in the present semester and the similar pattern will continue in next semester as well/
9. Dr. Anju Ahlawat was suggested to organize a First Aid course/workshop for faculty in the upcoming semester. Also, the Medical room visibility should be increased and display boards to be installed in the main building and hostel.
10. Dr. Vivek Solanki informed that the proposal for improvement in sports facility is under consideration by the management.
11. The feedback of students for upgrading the canteen, mess and sports facility will be forwarded by Director, MSIT to the management for taking steps for the improvement in the infrastructure and quality of food.
12. Smart Boards have been installed in Seminar halls and few labs that were received from Ambience Projects Pvt Ltd as donation. More boards will be installed in future.
13. A detailed discussion on the last 3 years budget held with the HODs and a file of departmental and institute budget will be maintained by the IQAC team.

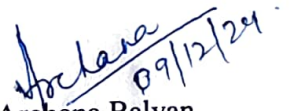
