The Department of Information Technology at Maharaja Surajmal Institute of Technology organized a seminar on the National Board of Accreditation (NBA) on 20th August 2025, in the IT Department. In addition, the Twelve Program Outcomes (POs), also known as Graduate Attributes, as defined by NBA, were explained in detail. To give a practical perspective, the Course Outcomes (COs) of the subject Artificial Intelligence were discussed, helping students understand how course outcomes are defined, measured, and attained.

The session concluded with an impactful discussion on the importance of NBA accreditation, especially in a developing economy like India. Ms. Mamta emphasized that the NBA not only ensures
