Key points discussed included

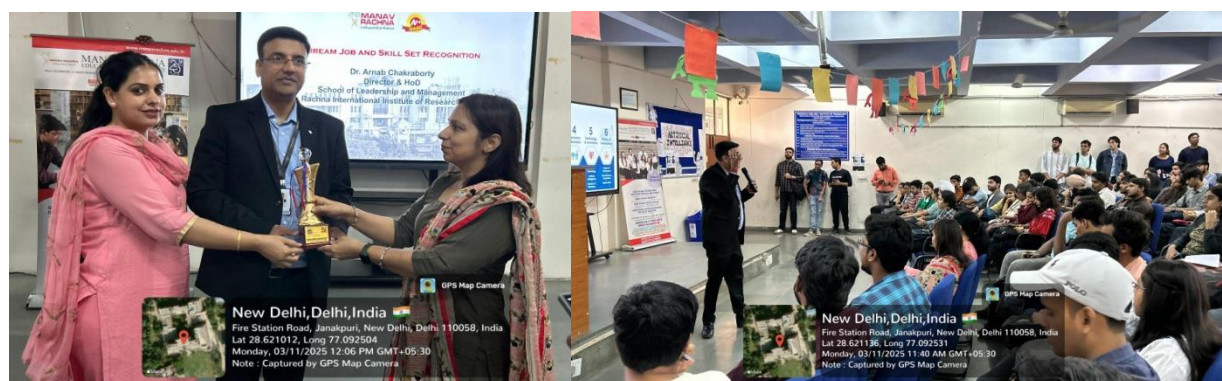
- Building a strong foundation in DSA, aptitude, and soft skills.
