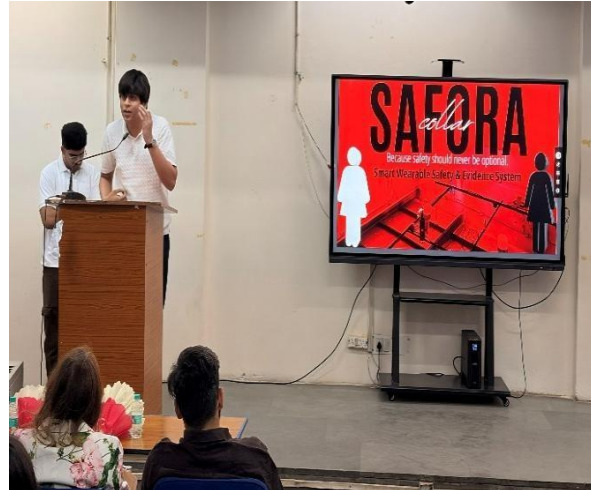
ECHOES OF INFLUENCE – SPEAKER SESSION

The competition witnessed a range of impactful ideas, and after thorough evaluation, Medivault secured the first position while Unsol emerged as the second runner-up, highlighting the strong entrepreneurial potential among participants.



STARTUP EXPO 2026
