Objectives of the Expert Lecture

To familiarize students with GGSIPU's new B.Tech. academic scheme; explain the credit structure and course groups; clarify the pathways for regular B.Tech., Minor Specialization and Honours; and guide students in planning electives and additional credits in later semesters.

Brief Report

The expert lecture "Types of B.Tech. Programs in GGSIPU" was conducted on 09 September 2026 for 3rd Semester IT (2nd Shift) students. Dr. Sitender explained the new B.Tech. scheme, including maximum, minimum and mandatory credit requirements; the BS, HS/MS, ES, PC, PCE and EAE/OAE course groups; and the provisions for first-year and lateral-entry students. The session highlighted the available degree pathways - B.Tech., B.Tech. with Minor Specialization, B.Tech. with Honours, and B.Tech. with Minor Specialization (Honours) - along with the role of electives and approved online/MOOC courses. Students also discussed how these choices affect their academic planning in subsequent semesters.

Outcomes of the Expert Lecture

After the session, students were able to understand the structure of the GGSIPU B.Tech. scheme, distinguish among the available degree options, identify the credit/elective requirements for Minor and Honours pathways, and make more informed decisions about future elective and credit choices.
